NAI Parsons Commercial Group - Boston is pleased to announce the opportunity to lease up 2,400 square feet of street level retail space in Downtown Natick, MA.

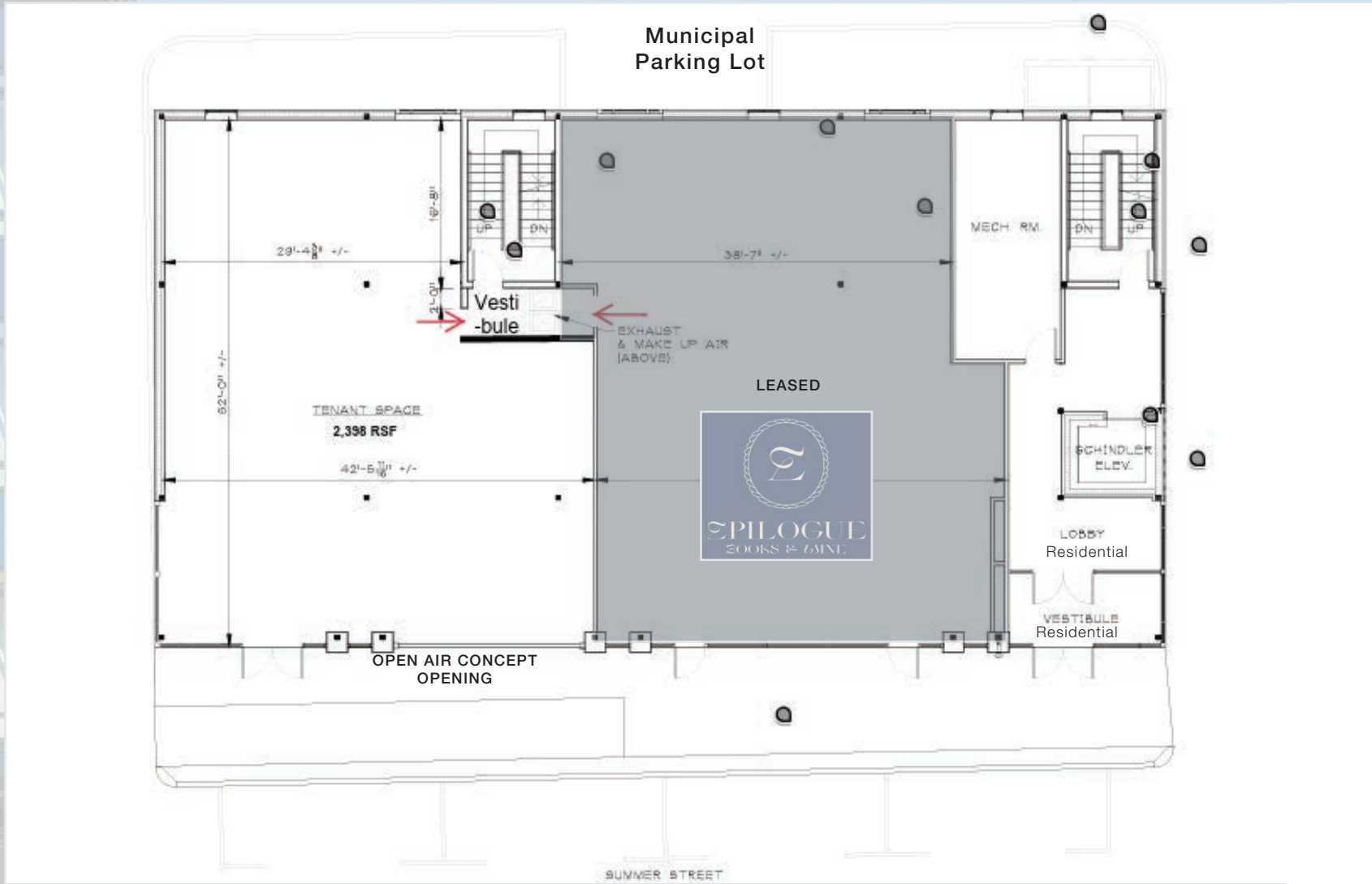
21 Summer Street is a newly developed mixed-use building featuring 13 residential units and the ground level commercial space.

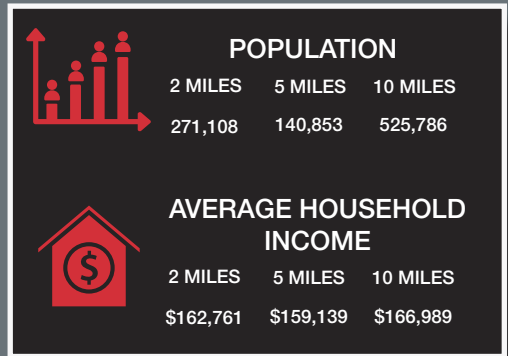

CENTRAL LOCATION



21 SUMMER STREET is located in the heart of downtown Natick, directly across from The Center for Arts in Natick (TCAN), a MetroWest cultural hub that attracts nearly 30,000 visitors annually and hosts approximately 300 events each year. The surrounding area also offers a vibrant mix of retailers, restaurants and town services, including the Natick Town Hall and The Morse Institute Library.

Additionally, the MBTA Natick Center Commuter Rail stop is located behind the property which provides convenient access to Boston in just 35 minutes, as well as to surrounding communities, making it an attractive location for businesses and visitors alike.
