The property is currently generating \$276,772 in annual net operating income and is offered at a 6.50% capitalization rate with a remaining lease term through June 2035. The lease features 7.5% rental increases every five years and includes three additional five-year renewal options, providing investors with a stable, long-term income stream backed by one of the nation's leading convenience retail operators.

This offering features an Absolute NNN Lease structure with zero landlord responsibilities, providing a passive ownership opportunity with predictable cash flow. Located along TX-31 in Chandler, TX, the asset benefits from strong regional connectivity within Henderson County and offers investors exposure to a durable retail tenant with scheduled rent growth and continued income stability.

LOCATION DESCRIPTION

TYLER, TX

Tyler serves as a major healthcare, education, and commercial hub for East Texas, providing regional services to surrounding communities across Smith County and beyond. The city has an estimated population of approximately 113,700 residents and functions as a key employment center supported by major healthcare systems, universities, retail destinations, and diverse industries.

Strategically located along major regional corridors including US Highway 69, State Highway 31, and Loop 323, Tyler offers strong connectivity throughout East Texas with convenient access to nearby communities and larger markets. The city's economy is anchored by leading employers such as CHRISTUS Trinity Mother Frances Health System, UT Health East Texas, Tyler Independent School District, Trane Technologies, Brookshire Grocery Company, the University of Texas at Tyler, and Tyler Junior College.

Tyler's diversified economy, supported by healthcare, education, manufacturing, retail, and professional services, provides a stable foundation for continued growth. The presence of major medical institutions, higher education facilities, and established employers strengthens the region's long-term demand for retail, services, and consumer-oriented businesses.

For single-tenant retail investors, the Tyler MSA offers a stable investment environment supported by a resilient healthcare-driven economy and diverse employment base. The region's retail market benefits from strong consumer fundamentals, including a cost of living 6.2% below the national average and a 4.16% increase in median household income in 2023. Continued infrastructure investment and proactive city planning further support long-term growth, enhancing the market's appeal for durable retail assets.

MAJOR EMPLOYERS

The subject property benefits from its proximity to Tyler, TX, the primary employment and commercial hub serving surrounding communities including Chandler. The region's economy is supported by a diverse mix of healthcare, education, manufacturing, and retail employers, creating a stable employment base and consistent consumer demand. Major employers including CHRISTUS Trinity Mother Frances Health System (~5,000 employees), UT Health East Texas (~3,550 employees), The University of Texas at Tyler, Tyler Junior College, Trane Technologies, and Brookshire Grocery Company contribute to the area's economic strength and long-term retail stability.

The presence of established industrial and corporate employers, including John Soules Foods and Tyler Pipe & Coupling, further diversifies the employment base and supports continued economic resilience throughout the East Texas region. This combination of institutional, healthcare, and private-sector employment provides a strong foundation for sustained consumer activity and demand for essential retail services.

Information About Brokerage Services

Texas law requires all real estate license holders to give the following information about brokerage services to prospective buyers, tenants, sellers and landlords.

TYPES OF REAL ESTATE LICENSE HOLDERS:

- A **BROKER** is responsible for all brokerage activities, including acts performed by sales agents sponsored by the broker.
- A **SALES AGENT** must be sponsored by a broker and works with clients on behalf of the broker.

A BROKER'S MINIMUM DUTIES REQUIRED BY LAW (A client is the person or party that the broker represents):

- Put the interests of the client above all others, including the broker's own interests;
- Inform the client of any material information about the property or transaction received by the broker;
- Answer the client's questions and present any offer to or counter-offer from the client; and
- Treat all parties to a real estate transaction honestly and fairly.

A LICENSE HOLDER CAN REPRESENT A PARTY IN A REAL ESTATE TRANSACTION:

AS AGENT FOR OWNER (SELLER/LANDLORD): The broker becomes the property owner's agent through an agreement with the owner, usually in a written listing to sell or property management agreement. An owner's agent must perform the broker's minimum duties above and must inform the owner of any material information about the property or transaction known by the agent, including information disclosed to the agent or subagent by the buyer or buyer's agent.

AS AGENT FOR BUYER/TENANT: The broker becomes the buyer/tenant's agent by agreeing to represent the buyer, usually through a written representation agreement. A buyer's agent must perform the broker's minimum duties above and must inform the buyer of any material information about the property or transaction known by the agent, including information disclosed to the agent by the seller or seller's agent.

AS AGENT FOR BOTH - INTERMEDIARY: To act as an intermediary between the parties the broker must first obtain the written agreement of *each party* to the transaction. The written agreement must state who will pay the broker and, in conspicuous bold or underlined print, set forth the broker's obligations as an intermediary. A broker who acts as an intermediary:

- Must treat all parties to the transaction impartially and fairly;
- May, with the parties' written consent, appoint a different license holder associated with the broker to each party (owner and buyer) to communicate with, provide opinions and advice to, and carry out the instructions of each party to the transaction.
- Must not, unless specifically authorized in writing to do so by the party, disclose:
 - o that the owner will accept a price less than the written asking price;
 - o that the buyer/tenant will pay a price greater than the price submitted in a written offer; and
 - o any confidential information or any other information that a party specifically instructs the broker in writing not to disclose, unless required to do so by law.

AS SUBAGENT: A license holder acts as a subagent when aiding a buyer in a transaction without an agreement to represent the buyer. A subagent can assist the buyer but does not represent the buyer and must place the interests of the owner first.

TO AVOID DISPUTES, ALL AGREEMENTS BETWEEN YOU AND A BROKER SHOULD BE IN WRITING AND CLEARLY ESTABLISH:

- The broker's duties and responsibilities to you, and your obligations under the representation agreement.
- Who will pay the broker for services provided to you, when payment will be made and how the payment will be calculated.
