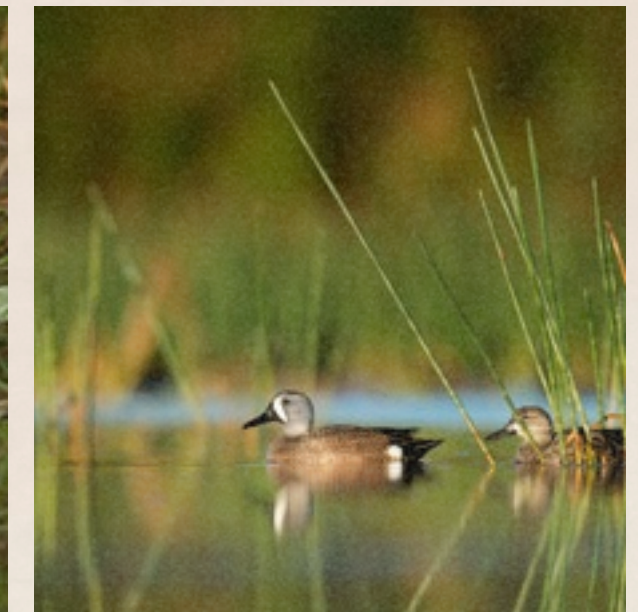
New herbaceous, bulb and shrub planting provide an attractive floral element, helping to break the quantum of existing greenery and enhancing the biodiversity of the site.
