'Left' Is the Storm in Fourteen Foreign Territories

With the growth of international touring in recent years and the demand for uniformity of the road, the "left" is still in order in fourteen territories, including Great Britain, according to a survey by the American Automobile Association.

Congress Requested to Designate Route Washington Memorial

Road Runs From Maine on Atlantic Seaboard to Florida

NEW YORK, March 7.—Much interest has been shown by congressmen along the Atlantic seaboard in the proposal to name the route extending from the Canadian line just above Calais, Me., to Miami, Fla., the George Washington Memorial Highway.

The plan was advanced with the idea of having the trail pass through the thirteen original colonies. It is sponsored by the George Washington Memorial Highway Association, with headquarters at Richmond, Va.

The highway, as outlined at present would follow the shore from its source through Boston, around into New York, where it would strike across into New Jersey, thence through Trenton, then Philadelphia, Wilmington, Baltimore and Washington, leaving
