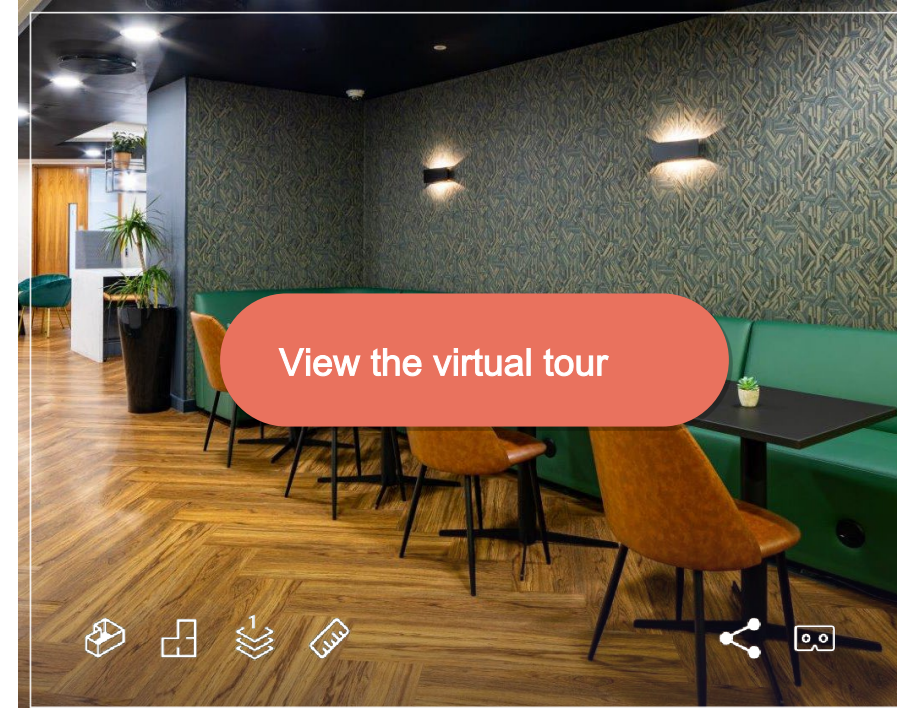


Indicative floor plans

75 King William Street Second Floor



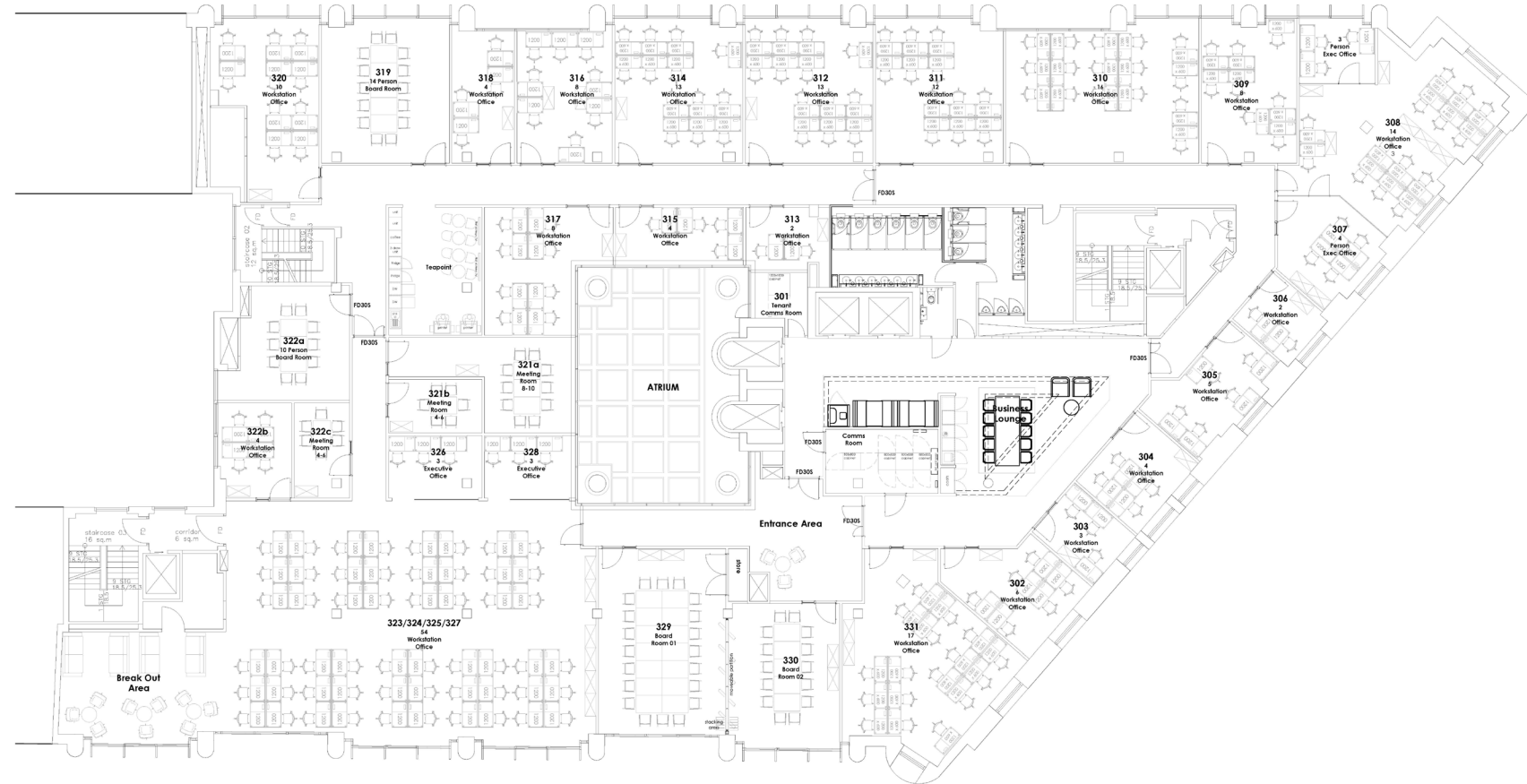

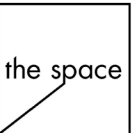

About the Building

Fitzroy Robertson modified the original building next to Clements Lane in 1986-89, with an extension to the left that included the vaulted entrance. 75 King William Street now consists of a lower ground and ground floor and seven upper floors located on the north-eastern side of the street, directly opposite a new entrance from Bank station.
