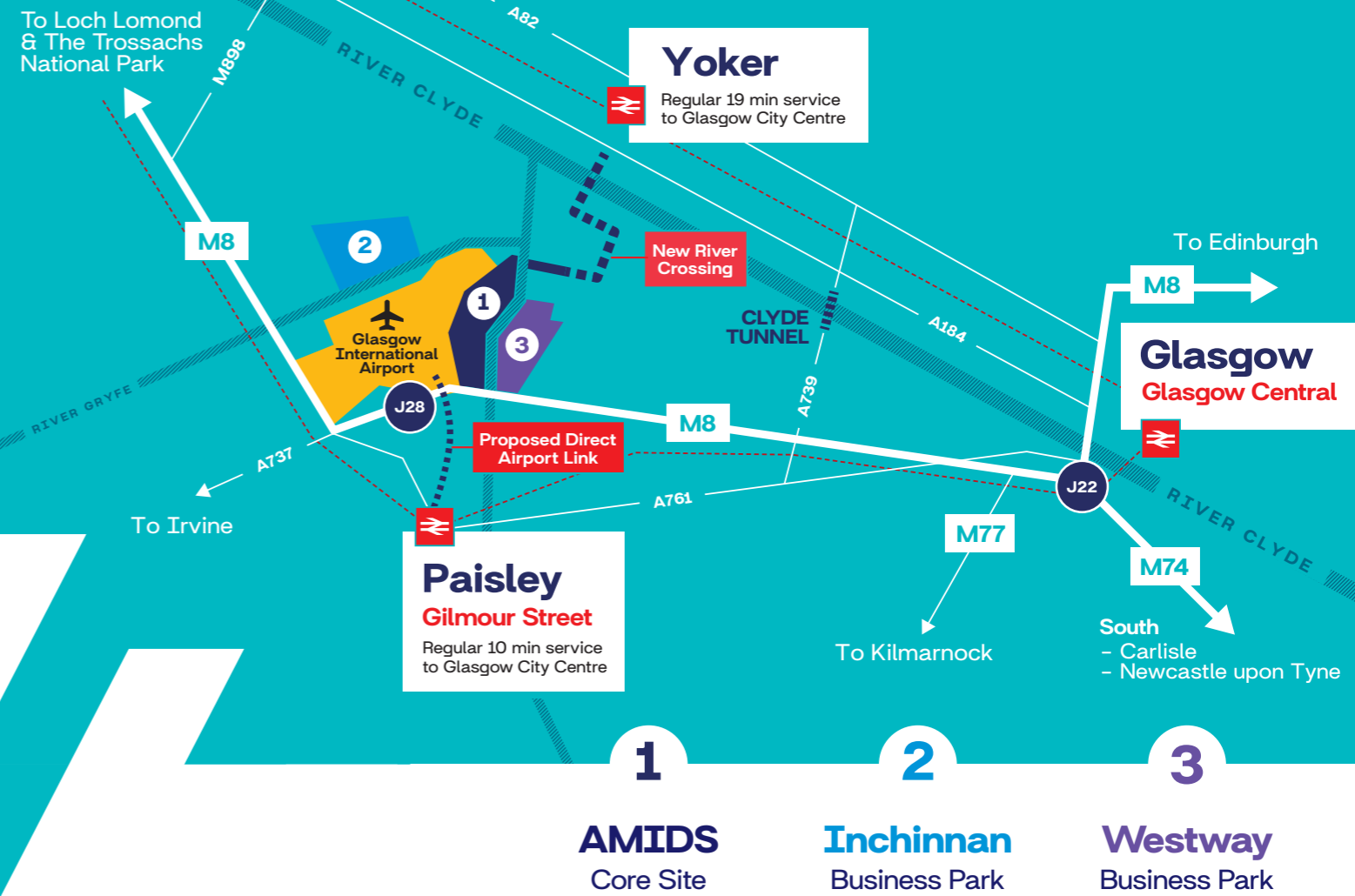
The National Manufacturing Institute Scotland is accelerating productivity to grow our economy, develop a vibrant workforce, and create happier, healthier, greener communities.

**Adjacent to Glasgow International Airport, Scotland's premier long-haul airport, AMIDS opens doors to global opportunities. 30 airlines servicing 120 destinations worldwide.**

Conveniently accessed via Junction 28 of the M8 Motorway, AMIDS is located approximately 7 miles to the west of Glasgow City Centre and lies immediately adjacent to Glasgow Airport.

The property is accessed via Abbotsinch Road and Nethererton Avenue, which subsequently connects to Sanderling Road which provides a link to the M8 Motorway via Junction 28.

The M8 Motorway is approximately 0.3 miles south of the property and provides direct access to Glasgow and Edinburgh to the east. It links with the M74 Motorway at Junction 22 providing access to Carlisle and the north of England. It also connects to Stirling and Northern Scotland via the M80 at Junction 13.
