PROJECT DESCRIPTION
Our client wanted to prioritize energy efficiency and sustainability and update the accessibility standards.

This extensive project encompassed the transformation of 88,000 square feet of space, involving demolition, core building upgrades, and the creation of six distinct areas. The upgrades included the installation of brand new bathrooms across six floors, modernization of the elevators, enhancements to the building's exterior with upgrades to 19 balconies, AV and lighting, and the installation of a new 15,000 SF TPO roof. Furthermore, the building's mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems were comprehensively upgraded, featuring new rooftop cooling towers on dunnage with mechanical screens, as well as new SCUs on all floors. The build outs comprised the development of a welcoming center, a new lobby with a striking monumental stair, a grocery store, a conference center, a daycare, and a clothing store.
